



A History Tour of Denbighshire

Thursday 26th January 2017



Itinerary:-

10.15am Depart Bodelwyddan Castle.

10.35am Arrive Denbigh and transfer to minibus to take you to Denbigh Castle where you will meet a guide who will talk about the history of the Castle.

11.30am Cae Dai Museum. 1950's museum (entrance fee £4.00 coffee supplied).

12.30pm Leave for Llanrhaeadr Village which has a Holy Well and the site of the oldest stained glass window in Wales.

1.00pm Lunch at The Lodge, Llanrhaeadr (not included in price).

2.15pm Leave for Ruthin, meet your Guide in the square who will give a talk about the history of Ruthin. If time allows, you can have a walk around this small historic town with its origins in the 13th century.

3.00pm Return to Bodelwyddan Castle.
